


Smart commuting to the port: fast, simple and affordable

Want to commute to work in the Port of Rotterdam quick, easy and at lower cost? Then choose one of the new, sustainable transport options: carpooling, vanpooling or the hopper. Prefer to drive yourself? With carpooling or vanpooling you can even earn extra money. Rather relax on your way to work? Then join a carpool or vanpool as a passenger, or take the hopper and get off close to your workplace. The choice is yours – simply pick the option that suits you best. Travel is free until 1 July 2026. After that, you will still receive a kilometre allowance.



1 Carpooling

- One employee drives and receives payment for each passenger.
- Plan ahead or book ad hoc.
- Best suited to regular daytime hours.


2 Vanpooling

- One employee drives and receives compensation.
- Departs from multiple residential locations.
- Ideal for shift work and irregular hours.



3 Hopper

- Shuttle service between Maassluis, Maasland (viaduct), Spijkenisse (centre), Brielle, Botlek, Maasvlakte and Europoort.
- Stops at participating companies free of charge (on request).
- Stops only with a booking.



How it works

- Go to commuting-to-the-port.nl.
- Complete the travel check tool to see which option suits you best.
- Choose your option: carpooling, vanpooling or the hopper.
- Register directly with Nabogo (carpooling) or Vipre (vanpooling), or book your ride via EBS (hopper).
- Get in and commute to work.

The benefits

- A more relaxed journey to work.
- Often cheaper than driving your own car.
- Earn extra money by driving.
- More flexibility in your daily commute.
- Free travel until 1 July 2026; after that you receive a kilometre allowance.

Earn extra as a driver

If you choose carpooling or vanpooling, you can sign up as a driver. This helps colleagues without a car – and you receive a fixed payment per trip.

Carpooling: €2 per passenger per trip + €0.10 per km above 10 km.

Vanpooling: €5 per trip.
