

Smart commuting to the port area – for employers too

Until 1 July 2026, employees can take part free of charge – so register your company today.




1 Carpooling

- Matches arranged via the Nabogo app.
- Plan ahead or book ad hoc.
- Best suited to regular daytime hours.
- Drivers receive €2 per passenger per trip, plus €0.10 per km above 10 km.
- Passengers travel free until 1 July; after that, the above costs apply.

2 Vanpooling

- One employee drives and receives compensation (€5 per trip).
- Departs from multiple residential locations.
- Ideal for shift work and irregular hours.
- Book via the Vipre app.



How it works for your employees

They:

- go to commuting-to-the-port.nl;
- complete the travel check tool to see which transport option suits them best;
- choose the option that suits them best: carpooling, vanpooling or the hopper;
- register directly with Nabogo (carpooling) or Vipre (vanpooling), or book a ride via EBS (hopper);
- get in and commute to work.

3 Hopper

- Shuttle service between Maassluis, Maasland (viaduct), Spijkenisse (centre), Brielle, Botlek, Maasvlakte and Europoort.
- Stops at participating companies free of charge.
- Stops only with a booking.
- Free until 1 July, after which the fare is €2.87 per trip, or €1.71 when boarding at a metro or bus station.
- Book via EBS.
